#### Christmas Tree by Boyd Webb

13 December 1991 - 5 January 1992

Each year the Tate Gallery invites an artist to decorate its Christmas Tree. This year the tree will be designed by Boyd Webb. Born in New Zealand in 1947, Webb has been working in London for nearly 20 years. His photographic images evoke a fantastic and dreamlike universe and, in recent years, have come to comment on the balance between man and nature.
