Turner Monet Twombly

22 June 2012 to 28 October 2012

Including over sixty works by JMW Turner (1775–1851), Claude Monet (1840–1926) and Cy Twombly (b1928), this stunning exhibition will explore the similarities between these artists in style, subject and artistic motivation in later life. Highlights will include a selection of Monet’s fabulous water lilies and Turner’s much loved, romantic landscapes.

Glam! The Performance of Style

8 February – 12 May 2013

Glam, a visually extravagant pop style which exploded across Britain during the years 1971–5, embraced high and low culture and played with identity and gender definitions. *Glam! The Performance of Style* at Tate Liverpool will be the first exhibition to explore glam style and sensibility in-depth, examining its relationship to painting, sculpture, film, performance and installation art in Britain, across Europe and in North America.

Chagall: Modern Master

7 June – 29 September 2013

Marc Chagall (1887–1985) is one of the great artists of the last century. Bringing together more than sixty paintings and a selection of works on paper from across the world, *Chagall: Modern Master* takes a fresh look at this compelling artist who created some of the most poetic and enduring images of the twentieth century. This exhibition will be the first major presentation of the Russian painter’s work in the UK for more than fifteen years.
