Created in 1995 to commemorate the brewery's 150th anniversary this is a rich, malty beer full of dried fruits and spice, with a clean hoppy finish.

Suthwyk Ales 'Liberation' (bottle conditioned) 500ml 5.50
Hampshire, England abv 4.2%

Light malty body with soft blackcurrant leaf and fruity hop notes

Copper Dragon Golden Pippin 500ml 5.50
North Yorkshire, England abv 4.2%

A light refreshing blonde ale, this is packed with fresh citrus notes, making this intensely refreshing.

Harviestoun 'Bitter and Twisted' 330ml 3.95
Alva, Scotland abv 4.2%

A light citrus led blonde ale

BEER

IPA & PALE ALE

Fourpure Pale Ale 330ml Cans 3.95
Bermondsey, London abv 5%

Clean, citrus led pale ale with grassy hop notes and a gentle caramel finish. Cans are considered the best medium in which to deliver hop forward beers as they retain freshness.

Weird Beard 'Mariana Trench' Pale Ale (bottle conditioned) 330ml 5.95
London, England abv 5-6%

Initially award winning home brewers the duo behind Weird Beard opened their brewery and make some of the best beers available. This is stunning pale ale with a strong malt background gives balance to fresh hop flavours of mango and passion fruit.

Kernel IPA (bottle conditioned) 330ml 5.95
London, England abv (6%-9%)

Kernel is a stone's throw from Tate. Evin the 'head brewer' is constantly innovating and changing hop varieties - please ask to see which of his styles we are currently stocking.

Siren 'Half Mast' QIPA 500ml 5.95
Berkshire, England abv 2.8%

A 'quarter' IPA, this is full flavoured with notes of mango and grapefruit this has a good malt backbone that provides structure for the hops, whilst remaining exceptionally drinkable at this lower abv.

Brewdog Jackhammer 330ml 6.95
Aberdeenshire, Scotland abv 7.2%

A beer that truly lives up to its name, this is a full flavoured punchy IPA, massive hop aroma of citrus and tropical fruit with a toffee malt finish.

Copper Dragon IPA 500ml 5.50
North Yorkshire, England abv 4%

This is a classic British style IPA, unlike its American cousins which are filled to the brim with fresh citrus and pine hop notes this is a more delicate variety. A well balanced fruity hop aroma with a biscuity malt body.

BEER

WHEAT, AMBER & OAK

Mondrian Beer (Bottle Conditioned wheat ale) 330ml 5.95

Liverpool Craft Beer Company, Merseyside, England abv 5.8%

Brewed to celebrate the Mondrian exhibition (currently on at Tate Liverpool). This is a Dutch inspired wheat saison.

Bad Seed Brewery Hefeweizen (Bottle Conditioned wheat ale) 330ml 5.95

Malton, North Yorkshire, England abv 5.1%

This is a refreshing light spicy wheat beer, cloves and pepper with a touch of banana.

Innis & Gunn 'Oak Aged Beer' 330ml 4.75

Edinburgh, Scotland abv 6.6%

Discovered, by accident, that maturing their beer in an oak barrels improved it. This was a stroke of luck as the results are superb, with its flavours of caramel and spice.

Redchurch 'Hackney Gold' (bottle conditioned) 330ml 4.95

London, England abv 5.5%

This is an amber ale with a nutty caramel flavour and a refreshing citrusy finish.

BrewDog '5 AM Saint' Red Ale 330ml 4.75

Fraserburgh, Scotland abv 5%

This ultra hoppy amber ale is an outstanding beer from Brewdog. Rich, nutty, caramel malt notes are superbly balanced with an intense burst of citrus, orange hop bitterness.

PORTER & STOUT

Pressure Drop 'Stokey Brown' (bottle conditioned) 330ml 5.95

Hackney, London abv 5.1%

Another of the now established London breweries, brown ales are seldom seen but not to be missed. Notes of toffee with an intense coffee finish and a gentle floral lift.

Harviestoun 'Old Engine Oil' 330ml 4.75

Alva, Scotland abv 6%

This fabulous name was dreamt up by the original head brewer. He previously designed model prototypes for Ford. The colour of his creation reminded him of thick engine oil.

Traquair 'Jacobite Ale' 330ml 6.95

Peebleshire, Scotland abv 8%

An intense, decadant beer blended with coriander and other spices.

Redchurch 'Hoxton Stout' (bottle conditioned) 330ml 4.95

London, England abv 6%

This delicious stout has intense flavours of chocolate and coffee with an espresso note coming through on the finish alongside a delicate hint of citrus hop notes.

BEER, CIDER, PERRY & MEAD

FRUIT & HONEY

Sam Smith's Organic Cherry Beer 330ml 4.95
Tadcaster, North Yorkshire, England abv 5.1%

If you have not tried a fruit beer before this is the perfect introduction. It is a lip-smacking mouthful of red cherries.

Gosnells Mead 330ml 5.95

London, England abv 5.5%

Mead unlike beer is made from honey, so all the flavour comes from the honey and the fermentation - this is a light crisp refreshing style with notes of elderflower and orange.

CIDER & PERRY

Dunkerton's Organic Cider 330ml 3.95
Herefordshire, England abv 7%

Cider is one of the great English beverages that after years in the doldrums is now booming. Ivor Dunkerton champions the use of ancient apple varieties and makes a satisfying, fresh, dry cider.

Burrow Hill 'Kingston Black' Bottle Fermented Cider 750ml 16.95
Somerset, England abv 8%

Burrow Hill were the pioneer of bottle fermented cider, utilising the same production methods as Champagne. Bone-dry, yeasty and complex it is the Dom Pérignon of the cider world.

Severn Perry 330ml 4.50
Gloucestershire, England abv 6.2%

Perry is made in the same way as cider, but with pears instead of apples. Made by Tom Bull this is a lovely off-dry, fruity example that is given extra dimensions of flavour by being matured in oak casks.

A BIT DIFFERENT

Wild Beer Company 'Ninkasi' 750ml 16.95
Somerset England abv 9%

This is a saison style ale made with copious amounts of New Zealand hops is then blended with Somerset apple juice and of course fermented with wild yeast. It then goes through a secondary fermentation in bottle with Champagne yeast. Deliciously confusing.
