### 2013 Crozes-Hermitage

Domaine Philippe & Vincent Jaboulet, Rhône Valley, France, abv 13%

Jaboulet is one of the great names of the Rhône and after the family business (Paul Jaboulet Aîné) was sold Philippe set up this tiny, high-quality domaine with his son Vincent. This is the essence of cool climate Syrah, unadorned by oak the bright fruit and spice shine through.

By moving our house wine, across Tate from bottles to bag-in-box we have improved quality (the same wine packaged in glass costs more) and done away with the need to ship from abroad, then remove and recycle fifteen tonnes of glass.

### Harviestoun 'Schiehallion' craft lager

Alva, Scotland, abv 4.8%

Clean, crisp and refreshing lager from one of the original 'craft' breweries.

### Artist and Empire IPA

Harbour Brewing, England, abv 5.5%

A collaboration brew with Harbour Brewing in Cornwall to celebrate the Artist and Empire exhibition. The origins, style and scale of India Pale Ale is much debated, but what is certain is that by the late eighteenth century a hoppy style of beer was being exported to India and drunk by the British living there. Our version draws on a mid-nineteenth century malt recipe and uses traditional British hops of the period. The label is an image of the original East India House on Leadenhall Street in London, headquarters of the East India Company who shipped the beers.

London, England, abv 5.2%

A light, refreshing, citrus led pale ale from another new in London's burgeoning beer scene. All their beers are canned, rather than bottled - this keeps it in the optimum condition.

3. GEVREY CHAMBERTIN  
The most celebrated of Red Burgundies. Medium strength. Fine and delicate. Serve slightly warmed with roasts.
4. HAUT SAUTERNES  
A great white Bordeaux wine. Soft and sweet. Serve cold with sweet or dessert.
5. GRAVES SEC  
A fine potent white Bordeaux with plenty of bouquet. Serve cool. At its best with hors d'oeuvre or grilled fish.
6. CHABLIS  
A beautiful pale gold, dry Burgundy of full strength. Serve cool. Ideal with oysters, hors d'oeuvre or grilled fish.
7. POUILLY FUISSÉ  
Dry, heady with a fine bouquet. A white Burgundy of distinction. Serve cool. Is perfect with steamed, creamed or boiled fish.

#### CHAMPAGNE BRUT

Really very dry and with no artificial sweetening added. You can drink it as an aperitif or with everything except cheese and sweet.
