As a publisher, we are proud signatories of the Publishing Declares pledge — working alongside other key industry organisations to collectively make a difference. Tate Publishing is committed to reducing its impact on the environment and adheres to sustainable working practices. Our books are printed on Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) materials, and we choose suppliers, printers and manufacturers who share our ethical values.

Making a Difference

As a self-distributing publisher, a key area of focus is the reduction of our carbon footprint in relation to the direct supply of our goods. We are seeking to reduce the number of smaller parcels shipped from our warehouse, whilst ensuring we can continue offering a fast and reliable service to our valued customers.

Moving Forward

We will continue to cover the shipping carriage (within the UK and Ireland) for trade orders with a net value of **£75.00** or more. We are confident our wide range of books across Exhibition and Trade, alongside our growing and diverse Children's offer, can make this threshold entirely manageable for all our customers.
