
Anthea Hamilton's installation *The Squash* disrupts the traditional gallery space.

Let's see how you can play a part in this.

REACT : INTERACT DISRUPT : INTERRUPT SIGHT : SOUND

Use this paper as a way of **interacting** with, and **reacting** to, things in the installation. The decision map below will help you choose how to **interrupt**, or **disrupt**, the traditional gallery space further using **sight** or **sound**.

Roll up your paper into a telescope and use it to survey the installation. Now roll it into a sound cone and use it to listen to the installation. Pick out a sound and remember it for later. Now pick one of the below items in theinstallation and move towards it.
