Queer and Now is a bold and safe digital community space for debate, not defamation. Acting with sensitivity and goodwill, we aim to spark progressive queer conversation and to resolve differences gently, by learning from each other's experiences and ideas.

Queer & Now is a Straight Edge space: alcohol, drug, cigarette, vape and weapon free.

Queer & Now's ethos is to 'Respect the person, challenge the behaviour'. So please keep this space free from aggression, assumptions, sexual harassment or prejudice based on race, ethnicity, sexuality, gender identity, ability, religion or beliefs, asylum status, language spoken, marital status or pregnancy and maternity.

We warmly welcome young people, but if you're under 18 or caring for a young person, please don't use your full name or give out personal details like social media handles or email addresses.

In an act of queer visibility and solidarity, if you feel safe to, please turn your cameras on. In discussions, please 'raise your hand' to speak to avoid interrupting others. It's also perfectly OK to be quiet and to sit back from it all. You can take a break, leave and come back any time.

The Queer & Now production team would like to recognise our privilege by keeping our cameras turned off. Please be mindful of your own.
