

IS FOR TANKS THE GHOST HAS NO SHELL!

My art practice is centred around collaboration, and the question, 'What can others bring to what I do or provide?' I build or create alternative spaces or objects and invite people to engage with them as a different way of experiencing art.

For me, No Ghost Just a Shell carries similar motivations. The artists, Pierre Huyghe and Philippe Parreno, provided the material – a character called 'Annlee' – and others were invited to collaborate and provide new experiences for 'Annlee', with no restrictions on what might be possible.

Explore the different artworks featuring 'Annlee'. What new experience would you create for this character if you could? Use the space on the page to draw or write your answer.

Now think of a character you have noticed in another artwork, or in a film, book or television programme. What new experience would you create for this character if you could?
